

Garden Report: September 2020

• Fall 2020 Installation:

- Extension Volunteers and UIUC Landscape Architecture and Horticulture classes helped to install ~1100 additional plants at the garden. New species include Virginia Bluebells, Shooting Star, Wild Hyacinth, Woodland Phlox and Nodding Onion.
- Orange Tulips to be installed the week of October 19th.

More Fall Plans:

Working with Ext. Hort. Educator Ryan Pankau and F&S to address Red Oak tree health.

New RORG Student Team:

 This semester, RORG is hosting a team of 4 students from UIUC Instructor Eric Green's Environmental Studies (ENVS) 492: Sustainability, Energy, and Environment Capstone class. They will be involved in our social media campaigns, soil health and stormwater data tracking, and documentation of various events taking place at the Rain Garden.

• Monitoring:

- o **CoCoRHaS** rain gauge watchers reported very few rainfall events over the past month.
- Soil: RORG Student Team performed soil infiltration testing using equipment loaned to
 us by UIUC Crop Sciences. Data was recorded and will be housed on our website in the
 future.

• Observations of note:

- September blooms: Purple Poppy Mallow, White Turtlehead, Purple Coneflower, Rose Mallow, Grey-Headed Coneflower, Black Eyed Susan, Royal Catchfly, Rosin Weed, Smooth Blue Aster. Fall 2020 Plant Collection and Zoom backgrounds are featured on the website.
- Build it and they will come: Many species of songbirds have been spotted in and around RORG. Finches have been seen eating seed from Coneflower and Rosin Weed.

Social media highlights:

- Kate Gardiner interviewed the designer of the Prairie Fire Sculptures found in the garden and wrote a popular <u>blog post</u> on them.
- Introduced our Fall Semester 2020 RORG Student Team members.
